



Increase in fertilizers, Herbicides and Labour costs




Although the Govt has no control over prices, we take full credit for this drop here...every 5 years

Labour force in cane plantation 1985 to 2009




Transport constraints

Plots too far from residence/moved to an area far from plot location




Plots frequently affected by wild and straying animals, pests and diseases

Financial constraints


- Exhausted years of savings

- Family income has drastically shrunk




Lack of institutional assistance

THE SMALL PLANTERS IN BUSINESS AND THE LANDS UNDER PRODUCTION?

Maintain full activity Remove and prevent illness

An Agricultural Land Policy

- The extent of land to be kept under agriculture for the coming 30 to 50 yrs
- Area dedicated to food crops
- Amenities and infrastructures (roads, irrigation network etc..)
- Needs for legal framework (agr. Land transfer, purchases, lease, taxes etc..)

A new Cane Policy based on the sustainability of the Cane Industry

- Review the Sugar Accruing Ratio
- Options to sell Raw or Refined
- Review payment policy of Sugar proceeds
- Bagasse price be at par with coal (3 /1)
- All final produce of molasses accrued to planters
- Banque Agricole

A Land Bank to cater for abandoned agricultural lands

- To motivate younger generationentrepreneurship
- Food production- food security
- Create family garden on the village boundaries
- Seed production in isolated regions
- Generate employments, provide physical exercise, produce goods and keep the island green

EU Accompanying Measures

- Be properly used to prepare small planters lands for full and part mechanization as per needs
- Enable the setting of the Land Bank and an exclusively Agricultural Bank
- Setting of a pension scheme for small planters passed 60 based on individual's life sugar production

SPMPC be equipped with Standing Cane Harvesters

- The only substitute to labour
- The only organization with know-how that can do the job
- Small planters are not ready for common management- better to have individual accounts

Sugar cane owners should have direct shareholding in cane related business concern.

- Power Plants
- Ethanol Plants
- Packaging and Bagging
- Bio-fertilizers plants (cane residue)
- And others to come

PLANTERS INDEBTEDNESS

 To review small planters' indebtedness vis à vis Financial institutions (DBM, MPCB, Leasing co, etc..) especially the rate at which they borrow money.

MINISTER'S RESONSIBILITY

 A quarterly National Monitoring Committee chaired by the Minister of Agro-Industry with all the stakeholders to take stock of the problems, find solutions, implement and make close follow-up of the situation
